On the “State Report Card” site’s homepage, there is a list of states in alphabetical
order. Click on any state whose report cards you would like to learn more about.

The search options and navigability for each state’s report card differ from state
to state, but a site will typically allow you to search for individual schools, districts,
and state-level reports. You can also search for whichever demographic via a
search engine. Student demographics (i.e. race, gender, etc.) are also available
for assessment.

Upon going to a report card, a series of data will appear containing a variety of
information about a school, district, or state. You can also search for data based on
previous school years. The type of data may vary from state to state. On the second
page is an example of one set of study results conducted by Gilbert Unified School
District (Arizona) for the 2021 - 2022 school year.
