AMERICA IS NOT A DEMOCRACY!

_____ describes a democracy in the following terms:

“Democracy is a system of government in which laws, policies, leadership, and major undertakings of a state or other polity are directly or indirectly decided by the ‘people,’ a group historically constituted by only a minority of the population adult citizens.”

- **“Democracy”** is derived from the Greek word **dēmokratía**, which comes from two words: **dēmos** (“people”) and **kratos** (“rule”) — a.k.a. “Power to the people.”
- Democracies were originally practiced among historical, tribal societies without cities or states. Eventually, the democratic political system was popularized in 5th-century Athens, Greece.
- Democratic government concentrates the power of control into the hands of the “majority” (i.e. the 51% rules the 49%).

History shows that the Founding Fathers were _____:

“The ancient democracies, in which the people themselves deliberated, never possessed one feature of good government. Their character was TYRANNY; their figure DEFORMITY.”

Another term for a Constitutional Republic is “Representative Democracy,” which means the government is elected by the people. Representatives are entrusted to act in the will and best interests of their constituents and secure the rights of every individual.

In the American Constitutional Republic or Representative Democracy, the rights of individual citizens are equally protected regardless of whether they belong to a minority or majority group.
